Dane County Emergency Management is hosting the National Weather Service's <u>Severe Weather Spotter Class</u> on Tuesday April 23, 2019. It will be offered twice, from 1:00-3:00 pm and again from 6:00-8:00pm at the Middleton Police Department (7341 Donna Dr., Middleton, WI). These classes are FREE of charge and no registration is required. The class will cover both storm spotter training and weather safety.
